What a busy week we have had! In maths this week, we have been focusing on fractions and we will continue to work on finding equivalent fractions. We have been using fraction walls and concrete resources to embed our learning.

In English lessons we are reading our class story 'The Wolves in the Walls'. We are continuing to use a range of skills such as adverbials for time and place to link our paragraphs together as well as apostrophes for possession to show ownership. The children are enjoying their writing and are always trying to upscale their vocabulary where possible.

In Geography this week, we have started a new topic looking at longitude and latitude. The children have also started learning about who Saint Paul was and different aspects of Christianity.
