



RECEPTION CLASS NEWSLETTER-Monday 12th January 2026

This week the children will be continuing their ice investigation predictions and carrying out their ice experiments; placing ice cubes in different places around school (radiators, outside in the cold, in the fridge and freezer). They will be observing changes to the ice and recording their findings, giving explanations. There will be sensory play in the ice tray as well as playing in the 'Winter home' role-play area and small world play. Our repeated read book this week is called 'Billy and the Beast' by Nadia Shireen. There will be the daily RWInc session and handwriting sessions across the week. In maths, the children will be focusing on comparing numbers using the maths vocabulary: 'more than' and 'fewer than.' As usual there will be lots of child-initiated learning in and outdoors.
