In Reciprocal Reading we will read a story. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

In maths we will continue with the topic about Length and Perimeter and will be learning about comparing, adding and subtracting length. Please encourage the children to measure different objects at home using rulers or tape measures.

We are also working hard learning our times tables and need to make sure that we master the 2,5,10,3,4 and 8 times tables by the end of Y3. Well done to all the children to have already achieved their bronze and silver badges.

In science we will learn about different types of soil.
