



RECEPTION CLASS NEWSLETTER-Monday 9th March 2026

This week the children will be observing any changes to their cress seed plant that has placed in the dark and their cress plant growing by the window. The children will also be watering their recently planted green beans. In maths the children will be focusing on doubling and recalling number pairs for numbers to 5. In R.E the children will be learning about forgiveness, building upon their understanding of the 'Joseph and his Multi-coloured Coat' bible story. There will be a collaborative multi-coloured Joseph coat collage to contribute to as well as other related provision activities. The children will be reflecting on forgiveness in their own lives as they create their own drawn symbol to add to our class Forgiveness Tree. There will be close observational drawings of our new tiny class caterpillars and Spring daffodils. As usual, there will be a high focus on oracy and back and forth conversations in the provision. There will be lots of child initiated play both in and outdoors.
