I hope you had a nice Easter break and enjoyed some lovely family time.

Our new topic for the summer term is *Ancient Greece*. We will read many myths and legends and learn all about this period in history.

This week in **English** we will read the *Ancient Greek* myth about Pandora's Box and start gathering skills for our next assessed piece of writing. We are going to write letter of apology from Pandora for opening the box and will include a variety of features in our letter e.g. direct speech, present perfect tense, a variety of sentence types and exciting vocabulary.

The spellings for this week are: **subzero, submarine, subway, subtitle, subheading, submerge.**

The spelling test will be on Friday as usual.

Please remember to read at home with your child and sign their **reading journal**. The reading journals need to be sent to school every day and books will be swapped on Thursday when it is our reading for pleasure day.

In maths we will start a new topic about Fractions. We continue revising the times tables focusing on 3, 4 and 8 especially. Please encourage your child to practice at home with TT Rockstars and work towards a times table badge.

In history we will start learning about *Ancient Greece*.

In music we will learn songs about *Ancient Greece* and start working towards a special performance about this historical period.

In science we will start a new topic about Plants. We will grow some plants at school and observe how they are developing.

In RE we will continue with the topic of Christianity and learn about the Trinity.

PE days are Wednesday and Thursday. Please remember that your child needs to wear a PE kit to school on these days.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

Our next school trip will be a joint visit with class 4 to visit different places of worship in Bradford on the 27th April. Please organise payment for the trip if you have not already done so.
