This week in **English** we will continue working with the text about Pandora's Box and keep gathering skills for our next assessed piece of writing. We are going to write letter of apology from Pandora for opening the box and will include a variety of features in our letter e.g. direct speech, present perfect tense, a variety of sentence types and exciting vocabulary.

The spellings for this week are: **scene, seen, weak, week, weather, whether**. The spelling test will be on Friday as usual.

In Reciprocal Reading we will be reading an Ancient Greek about Medusa and we will answer a variety of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

In maths we will finish our topic about Fractions. Please encourage your child to continue practicing their times tables at home and use TT Rockstars.

In history we will learn why were Athens and Sparta so different.

In music we will sing songs about the Ancient Greece.

In science we will continue with our new topic about Plants.

In RE we will learn about John the Baptist.

In art we will create a collage based on the myth about Medusa.

PE days are Wednesday and Thursday. Please remember come in a PE kit on these days.

Homework this week will be on My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

Our next school trip will be a joint visit with class 4 to visit different places of worship in Bradford on the 27th April. The children need to come to school in their full uniform and bring a packed lunch and a water bottle. We will leave at 9am and return at 3.30pm.

On Tuesday, the 19^h May, we will have a special Ancient Greek day. We will dress up as Ancient Greeks and we will have lots of special activities which will help the pupils learn many new things about this topic. The children need to come to school dressed up as Ancient Greeks in a costume. (A white tunic can be made out of a piece of white fabric, white sheet or pillowcase.) If you have difficulty sorting out an outfit, please let me know and your child can borrow something from school. **We will also present a short performance about Ancient Greece** to the rest of the school.
