We had a wonderful visit to Bradford, where our trips to both the mosque and the Hindu temple were incredibly informative. The children thoroughly enjoyed learning about these different places of worship; they shared their knowledge confidently and asked some excellent questions. In history we will continue learning about Ancient Greece.

In music we will sing songs about the Ancient Greece.

In science we will learn about what plants need to grow and we will discuss the results of our experiment.

In RE we will learn about John the Baptist.

PE days are Wednesday and Thursday. Please remember to come in a PE kit on these days.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

On Tuesday, the 19^h May, we will have a special Ancient Greek day. We will dress up as Ancient Greeks and we will have lots of special activities which will help the pupils learn many new things about this topic. The children need to come to school dressed up as Ancient Greeks in a costume. If you have difficulty sorting out an outfit, please let me know and your child can borrow something from school. **We will also present a short performance about Ancient Greece** to the rest of the school.
