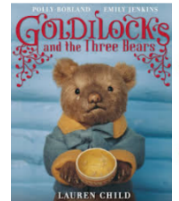


# Great Gorillas Newsletter

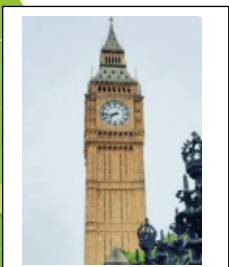
**The times tables test will be based on the 5x tables.**
