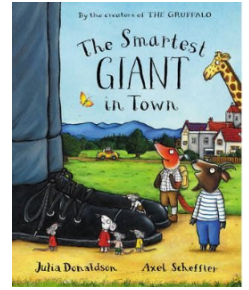


# The Smartest Giants in Tankersley
