Dear parents/ carers,

I hope you had a lovely weekend.

This week in **English** we will focus on revising some grammar including the present perfect tense, possessive pronouns, subordinating conjunctions and complex sentences.

The spellings for this week are: **material, position, business, earth, possess**. The spelling test will be on Friday as usual. The children are doing really well with their spellings so please keep practicing at home.

In Reciprocal Reading we will read the Ancient Greek myth about Orpheus. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

In maths we will continue with our topic about telling time. We will learn about digital time, am and pm, years, months and dates.

In science we will continue with our topic about Plants.

In history we will learn about the Ancient Greek Olympic games.

In RE we will learn about the difference between infant and adult baptism.

PE days are Wednesday and Thursday. Please remember to come in a PE kit on these days.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

On Tuesday, the 19th May, we will have a special Ancient Greek day and the children need to come to school dressed up as Ancient Greeks. **We will also present a short performance about Ancient Greece to the rest of the school. Parents and carers of Y3 children are invited to come and watch the performance which will start at 2.45pm.**

Our next church service, The Clyppings service, will take place on **Wednesday 20th May at 9.30 am** in Tankersley Church. Pupils from Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will attend the service alongside staff. We would be delighted if you could join us for this special occasion and help us continue to celebrate and preserve our local traditions.

Our final school trip of the year will take place on Thursday 16th July, when we will be visiting the Magna Science Adventure Centre. The cost of this visit has been significantly reduced and you will only need to pay for the coach travel. MAGNA have kindly offered us a free visit in return for permission to capture parts of the day through photographs or video footage. As we already hold your consent for external media, there are no additional forms to complete. I am sure the children will have a fantastic time and that the visit will further deepen their scientific knowledge through both the workshop activities and the interactive exhibits.
