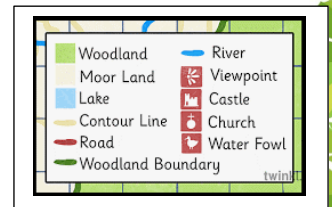
Please continue to practise the times tables, children should be fluent at recalling the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables by the end of Y2.
