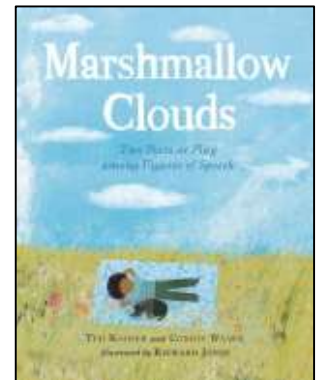
Hello parents and carers,

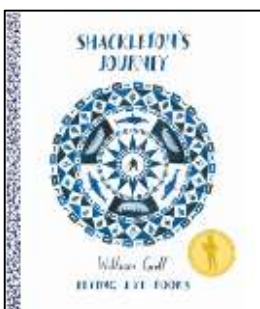
Swimming - the final swimming date is Thursday 2nd July. After this date, PE days will return to Mondays and Wednesdays.

What have we been learning this week?

- **Maths** - We are learning about Shape - angles and turns; triangles; quadrilaterals; polygons; lines of symmetry.
- **English** - We have just finished a poetry unit based on a poem from 'Marshmallow Clouds'. The children were very creative and some of these poems genuinely moved me when reading them!



We are now reading 'Shackleton's Journey' by William Grill. The children had to write a job application to become a crew member aboard the Endurance ship. They then thought of some interesting job interview questions, talked about body language and eye contact, and then interviewed each other. I'm pleased to say everyone got the job, although I suspect we may have a stowaway on board!

- **Computing** - Micro:Bits - Creating step counters, night lights, noughts and crosses, and dice.
