This week we will finish our formal learning and revise what we have covered in all the different curriculum areas. The children have done very well in last week's assessments and I am very pleased with the progress they have made.

The spellings for this week are: **younger, blue, plague, chord, weekly, system, illegal.**

In maths we will return to the topic about time as the children find it particularly challenging. It is an important life skill so please encouraged them to tell the time at home too. We will also continue practicing our times tables so the children are as ready as possible for year 4. **By the end of year 3 the children should be really confident with their 2,5,10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables.**

In music we will continue learning to play the ukulele.

In science we will continue learning about Forces and Magnets.

In RE we will finish our learning about the Bible.

In Geography we will finish our learning about the UK.

PE day is Wednesday. The children need to come to school wearing their PE kit.

Homework this week will be on My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

On Thursday 16th July it is our trip to Magna. We will explore the exhibits to deepen our scientific knowledge, take part in an interactive workshop and also spend time in the adventure playground and the water park. **The children will need to wear uniform for this trip** but also bring a towel, crocs or sandals and a full change of clothes. They can also bring £5 spending money for the shop.
