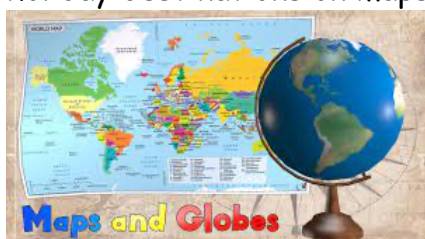


Nursery Newsletter
