Dear parents/carers,

1. Please look at the video below to learn more about the pure RWInc letter sounds that we all need to model to our children. For example for 'm' we don't say "muh" but "mmm." This makes it easier for the children to hear and blend the sounds together when orally blending and reading.

2. **Fred Talk:** Please help your child to orally blend 2 and 3 letter words. E.g You say "u-p." Your child repeats and this turn taking to repeat the sounds leads to blending "u-p, up." Or "s-a-d" repeated until your child hears and says "sad."

3. **Individual Letter sound cards:** Please support your child to be able to recognise and say the individual letter sounds for each of the 5 letter cards sent home every week. You may start off with one or two cards and once your child is confident with saying the sounds independently, you could introduce a new sound card to learn. The picture on the back of each card is there to give your child a pictorial image to help him or her to remember the letter sound.



4. **Blending letter card sounds together to read:** Please help your child to blend letter sounds together to read 2 and 3 letter words (containing the sounds that they already know)
